

ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

Rolland Harve Golden

(American, New Orleans 1931 - 2019)

Acclaimed southern artist Rolland Golden has earned a place in the canon of American masters alongside Grant Wood, Rockwell Kent and Edward Hopper.

Born in New Orleans and trained under notable artist and instructor John McCrady (whose own artistic lineage traces to the Art Students League of New York and his teacher Thomas Hart Benton), Golden's career spanned six decades. In 1976 he was chosen as the only American realist painter to represent the United States on a cultural exchange art tour of soviet Russia. He received dozens of awards and accolades throughout his career, and in 2014 he was honored with an exhibition at the Ogden Museum of Southern Art.



Golden was collected widely during his lifetime by international visitors to New Orleans and his work continues to attract an avid widespread collector base to this day.

Golden's longevity and success as an artist can be attributed to his unique melding of tradition and modernity. Grounded in the deep fundamental training of his academy days, he departs with deliberate care from literal realism toward a self-named 'borderline surrealism' in his highly colorful oil, watercolor and acrylic paintings.

These are not the melting clocks of Dali or the fruit-heads of Magritte; Golden's surrealism has a soft, dreamlike quality that tugs on the imagination and transports the viewer – all in service of his desire to provoke a heightened emotional experience.
